Objective:

to help necessitous parents with children under 13 years of age within the London Borough of Wandsworth, by providing grant funding of up to £5,000 to voluntary and some public sector organisations who provide services in line with this objective



Organisations must fulfil the following criteria:

- Based in London Borough of Wandsworth (LBW) or delivering services in LBW
- All beneficiaries must live in LBW
- Must be properly constituted and supply copies of their constitution, details of their Board of Trustees or Management Committee structure



- Must have correct policies in place for the activities they carry out i.e. child protection, equal opportunities, Criminal Record Bureau checks for volunteers and staff
- must hold own bank account with a minimum of 2 signatories
- must be able to provide management accounts or audited accounts (these must be no older than 15 months)
- Referees may be requested in support of the application



Examples of funded projects

- Spacemax – costs for refurbishing houses to improve space useage
- CCHF All About Kids – costs for adventure breaks for children from disadvantaged backgrounds
- Albemarle school – capital costs for equipment as part of refurbishment
- Mercy Foundation – contribution towards costs for homework club
- Wandsworth Home-Start – contribution to salary costs for volunteer co-ordinator
